

Installing software titles to a RM CC3 network

Preparation: Ensure that you have a clean location and clean stations and have reset the Packagebuilder user profile.

Step 1 - Using RM Application Wizard 2

- Log on as Packagebuilder with the password *changeme*.
- Insert the iR CD title requiring installation.
- Open **RM Application Wizard 2** and select 'Manage a Windows Installer Package' and Next.
- Select 'Create a Windows Installer package' and Next.
- At the next screen, provide a name of the package you are about to create, along with a description e.g.
Name: Primary Games Vol.4
Description: Numeracy Software
- Click 'Next' to continue.
- A scan of your workstation will now start. After a few minutes the scan will complete, at this point choose 'OK'

Step 2 - Installing the iR title

You are now asked to select a file to launch. You will need to navigate your way to the '**Setup.exe**' on the CD-Rom drive. For the following titles this can be found in the '**fscommand**' folder:

Maths Pack Three

Teaching Measures

Teaching Money ('setup1.exe' for Sterling, 'Setup2.exe' for Euro)

Primary Games Vol.3 & 4('setup1.exe' for Primary, 'Setup2.exe' for Secondary)

For the Teaching Tools CD-ROM:

Setup1.exe = Maths Pack 1

Setup2.exe = Maths Pack 2

Setup3.exe = Teaching Time

Setup4.exe = Teaching Tables

Setup5.exe = Primary Games Vol.1

Setup6.exe = Primary Games Vol.2

- Choose the appropriate file and select 'Open'

- A window appears in top left indicating 'Package build in progress'. At this moment in time do not close this window or 'Start the second scan'
- Follow the onscreen instructions and enter your unique user code when prompted.

Step 3 - Take the Second Scan

- After set up is complete remove the CD.
- Start the Second Scan. Make sure 'Continue building package' is selected and choose 'Next'.
- When the 'After snapshot complete' window is displayed. Select OK to continue.
- The MSI has now been created. Choose 'Finish'

Step 4 – Make shortcuts available to users including allocating the iR title package.

- Log off as 'Packagebuilder' and log on to the RM Management Console as 'Systemadmin'.
- Expand the **Resources** icon in the left-hand pane.
- Choose **Program Sets** and decide where the iR title will reside. Right-click (e.g. Accessories) and select **Properties**.
- Select the **Shortcuts** tab to display the Shortcut Property page.

The source drop-down field can be used to select application shortcuts that are available. When you install a new application with RM application Wizard your application will appear in the **Application Packages** list under **Source**. Highlight the name of the iR title you have just installed and new shortcuts for it will appear in the middle pane.

- Select the *iR title.exe* and choose the button with the > sign on it to move the shortcut into the Selected Shortcuts list in the right-hand pane.
- Select 'OK'

We now need to allocate our new package to other workstations on the network.

- Within the RM Management Console select the appropriate stations and choose **Properties** from the menu that appears.
- Choose the **Packages** tab
- From the list of Available Packages select the package for the iR title you have just created and choose **Allocate**, then **OK**.
- Exit the RM Management Console and Restart the workstations which have been allocated the package. The station on which the package was created will also need to be restarted.

The software is installed and ready for use.
